If you just called on the name of the Lord - You are saved! (Romans 10:13) "If anyone is in Christ he/she is a new creation; old things have passed away, behold, all things have become new." (I Corinthians 5:17) When we received Jesus, we literally became alive from the dead in God's eyes. We also have Christ's kingdom in operation on the inside so that we have authority and overcoming power from God to destroy, overthrow, eliminate, uproot, tear down, obliterate every work of the devil. Jesus is our King and His government is within us. Therefore, stay close to Christ by developing and maintaining a strong prayer life. (Colossians 1:20) We are bold to speak up about how Jesus bore our sins on the Cross, took our sins and evils we once committed when He died, and gave us a death-crushing and sin-destroying power when He arose from the dead. Real Christians DON'T serve a man-made religion, an angel, a prophet, a good teacher, a philosophy, or a dead god. As the people of God, we serve, worship and know the One and only LIVING God, who speaks, reveals Himself personally, and demonstrates His power to save, deliver, and heal today. Our faith is not in Jesus' humanity of the past, but in Jesus Christ, our resurrected Lord and Savior in the present. We call Him Lord because He is our Owner. He is God our salvation. We are not ashamed to let others know about God's love and power save people today.

Something powerful happens when we truly surrender our life to Jesus and renounce a lifestyle of sin - our sins are canceled, emotions are restored, our soul is redeemed, and we have fellowship with God. The same way a child is born of its mother, you were just now born of God. A life surrendered to Jesus is never wasted.

- > At peace with God (Roman 5:1)
- ➤ Protected from demonic torment (Colossians 1:13, 2:15)
- ➤ Able to have access to God at any time (Ephesians 5:2)
- **Capable of forgiving all people** (John 20:23)
- ➤ Possessing eternal life (John 3:15-16)

It's time to get serious about Jesus! Sin kills - Jesus heals. Therefore, count yourself dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus. A life without God is a life without meaning. If you are pleasing God, it doesn't matter how others may object. Everyone will have to answer God for their own life one day. (*Romans 14:10-12; 2 Corinthians 5:10*)

When you give 100% to knowing and loving God, you will experience 100% joy in your salvation. So, why not go all the way in serving the only One who can give you life to the fullest? Your peers cannot give you abundant life, nor can they take you to Heaven. Our here and now is an opportunity to get to know Jesus, so He is no stranger when we get to

Heaven. We love God because He first loved us. (1 John 4:19) You will find that you want to express that love in your life by growing in faith and by helping others.

## There are five important things you DO to kick-start your new life.

- 1) FIND A GOOD CHURCH. A church is a place where Christians build their relationship with God and one another. A real church is NOT an individual, a building, or an organization; it is one BIG Family. God sees us as parts of one body that has unique functions. Christ Jesus is the head that body. - 2) WATER BAPTISM. Water baptism is your first exciting step of obedience before the Lord. You make a public declaration of your faith in Christ and that you are a member of His one body. You identify yourself with His death, burial, and resurrection. When Jesus died, our old sinful nature died with Him when He was buried, we were joined into Him, as He rose from the grave, so are we raised to a new life with Him that defeats sin and death. He empowers you to be holy and serve Him. (Acts 2:41)
- **3) PRAY.** Talk and listen to God. He hears you and does answer. Keep your relationship with God current and close. You can pray anywhere everyday at any place. Ask the Lord to give you a passion to know, love and serve Him. When you look for Me, you will find Me. When you wholeheartedly seek Me, I will let you find Me, declares the LORD. (*Jeremiah. 29:13-14a*) God knows everything we need. Let Him show you how big He really is. (*I Thessalonians 5:17*)
- **4) READ THE BIBLE.** Read the word of God daily. It's a good habit that will strengthen your faith and feed your soul. It is God's love letter to you. Its histories are true, its miracles are authentic, and its words are Godbreathed. God will reveal Himself through His scriptures. God wants us to know and love His word. It most accurately describes: the condition of mankind, the nature of God, how to be right with God, and our purpose for living. It will guide you until death. (*Psalms 119: 105, I John 2:5*)
- 5) OBEY GOD MOMENT BY MOMENT. You are not an accident! God thinks you are special and worth dying for. He made you unique and gave you a life mission that only you can do. We are so valuable to God that it cost His sinless son's life to bear and take away our sins. He bore them on the cross, so that we cold fulfill our purpose in God. Our life is now encased with Christ in God. Our love for God now motivates us to worship and serve Him. Jesus said, "he who stands firm to the end will be saved." (Mark 13:13) God expects is children grow-up to be like Christ. The sign that you are truly saved is that God's Holy Spirit actively corrects us when we do wrong, and that we continue to repent of sin and have a God-given desire to please and worship Him. Therefore we must continue to examine ourselves to see if we are in the faith. "Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?--unless indeed you are disqualified." (2 Corinthians 13:5; Luke 12:8-9; John 14:21)
